Key Reading/Writing Concepts

- **Letter recognition/ both upper and lower case**
- **Writing first and last name**

Spalding is the phonics program taught at Legacy. It is different than what is taught in many other school systems. Key Math Concepts

- **Number Identification** (be able to count to 50 and write their numbers)
- **Complete a pattern**
- **Sorting, classify, and order objects by size, number and other properties**
- **Recognize shapes**
- **Counting objects**
- **Matching a sets of objects with 1-to-1 correspondence**

Math Facts are an important part of our students' education. They will take weekly test

for addition and/or subtraction. These tests are 20 problems and they are graded. (*Over the summer is a great time to purchase flash cards and have your student practice with them.*)

Special Projects/Curriculum Notes

Each student will be responsible for completing one (1) book report and one (1) poem recitation for each grading period. They will receive a packet at the beginning of each grading period that will give them more information regarding these projects.
