In December 2019, Legacy's board approved a 5% base salary increase for 2020-21 for all Legacy teachers based on their 2017-2018 base salary. Accordingly, all Legacy teachers will receive a 5% increase for 2020-21 based on their 2017-2018 base salary. The average percentage increase differs from 5% due to changes in teaching staff, resulting in varying salary levels based on new teacher recruitment and each individual's years of experience and degrees.
