5. Provide staff members with ongoing professional development that supports the education of the child	Trainings quarterly for all staff Monthly meeting for all staff Texas School Ready Summer Conference Early Years training for teacher staff Curriculum training for teacher staff
6. Evaluate family engagement efforts and use evaluations for continuous improvement	Use survey results to provide information about the current program. Revise and review the Family Engagement Plan annually.
